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## Project Guidelines:

1. Your Kahoot must be at least 10 questions, but not more than 15
2. Your Kahoot must have:
a. at least 2 questions that define vocab
b. at least 5 questions with a diagram
c. test/ exam level questions
3. Your Kahoot must have accurate spelling and grammar and use of vocabulary
4. Your "correct" answers must be correct!
5. Your questions must be varied to cover the information in your sections
6. Content must be appropriate for school
7. Share with Kahoot user: strattla

## Project Hints:

1. Look at study guide/ review sheet(s) for inspiration
2. Don't make a super easy quiz. You aren't helping anyone on the exam if it is too easy. [but don't make it impossible either-exam level questions!]
3. Don't limit yourself to the diagram limit... this is Geometry! Diagrams are EVERYWHERE! In fact, feel free to put a picture of something geometric even if your problem is diagram free - it makes it more fun!
4. Use the rubric below to guide you
